Hollybank was established in 1983 in what was, before its careful conversion, a series of brick-built farm buildings known as "Shotton farm".

A range of care services for older people are provided in addition to permanent residential care, short term respite care and day care services are offered. These additional services may be particularly helpful to those who care for a relative at home and need some relief or a holiday themselves. Respite and day care services may be arranged on a regular or occasional basis subject to availability.

Hollybank caters for a range of personal care needs for older people that includes sensory impairment, physical disabilities, chronic health conditions and those with early stages of dementia.

The accommodation consists of three small separate “houses” centred around our courtyard garden, each with its own unique character and homely feel. The spacious gardens are well laid out and there is a choice of lounges, dining rooms and conservatories where residents can enjoy their time.

All staff are highly trained and experienced in the care sector and the vast majority hold an NVQ/QCF level 2 or 3 in Health & Social Care. Hollybank is proud of the high standards and professionalism of all staff, which is demonstrated by the excellent reputation held locally for providing high quality care.



A trial day or a trial period of up to four weeks is offered to help potential residents ascertain whether they would like to reside at Hollybank on a long-term basis.
